PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Grants a Motion)**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On July 12, 2024, Foothills Water & Sewer, LLC (“Foothills” or “Company”), the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”), and the Residential Utility Consumer Office (“RUCO”) (collectively “the parties”) filed a Joint Motion for a Procedural Order. The parties requested an extension of the deadline to file their Settlement Agreement from July 12, 2024, to July 16, 2024. In addition, the parties requested an extension of the deadline to file the Notice of Manner of Participation to July 19, 2024. The parties also requested elimination of the requirement to file summaries of witness testimony and an issues matrix in light of the settlement.

The parties’ request is reasonable. In addition, the website notice required by the Procedural Order dated July 3, 2024, should be updated to reflect the new anticipated date of filing the Settlement Agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties shall file the Settlement Agreement by July 16, 2024.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file the Notice of Manner of Participation by July 19, 2024.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties are no longer required to file summaries of witness testimony and an issues matrix.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Foothills Water & Sewer, LLC** shall update the notice
2 posted on its website to reflect the revised anticipated date of filing the Settlement Agreement.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
4 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision
5 in this matter is final and non-appealable.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
7 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
8 hearing.
