

Hydrant Flushing Notice

Foothills Utilities will be conducting the annual routine fire hydrant flushing throughout the water system beginning **05/11/2026** through **08/10/2026**.

This important maintenance helps:

- Improve water quality by removing sediment from water mains
- Reduce water age by bringing fresh water into the system
- Maintain more consistent and effective disinfectant (chlorine) levels
- Ensure adequate flow for fire protection

What to expect during flushing:

- Temporary drops in water pressure
- Discolored water (yellow, brown, or rusty appearance)
- Cloudy or milky water (caused by tiny air bubbles)
- Possible temporary chlorine taste or odor changes

Is cloudy water safe?

Yes. Cloudy or milky water is typically caused by air and is safe to drink. Fill a clear glass and let it sit—if it clears from the bottom up, it is air.

What should you do?

- Run cold water for several minutes until it clears
- Avoid using hot water if discoloration is present
- Delay laundry, especially white or light-colored fabrics, until water runs clear
